WHAT IS THE UNE STUDENT CONSULTATIVE COMMITTEE?

The UNE Student Consultative Committee is established to provide an effective mechanism for student engagement for staff-student partnership in decision-making. This Committee is designed to encourage a culture of open and accessible student engagement and representation based on principles of authentic partnership.

The Committee will:

1. Represent all UNE students in matters affecting, or of concern to them within the University;
2. Provide an opportunity for students to participate in decision-making processes, and to provide feedback to the University;
3. Provide a forum where students can provide feedback on course matters, including development of new course offerings across discipline areas
4. Aid in the co-creation of solutions, and development of new and innovative ideas and practices;
5. Provide a forum for University representatives to respond to issues raised by student representatives.

Responsibilities:

- Attend Forums once per Trimester to discuss student issues and co-create solutions with staff
- Participate in preparation meetings for these forums, and engage with staff and students
- Facilitate student feedback on a range of matters via surveys, emails and focus groups
- Assist in reporting outcomes to students

SCC Representatives will receive:

- Induction training to the SCC, their role and responsibilities
- Professional development training throughout their representative term
- On-going support and staff liaison
- Formal recognition via a personalised certificate of appreciation and letter of recommendation

HOW TO JOIN THE SCC

SCC is a two-year commitment (preferred), however is negotiable for a single year where appropriate.
